

Welcome to Physical Therapy and Sports Medicine

- 1. You must bring your Buck ID with you to every visit to verify your appointment and confirm enrollment status and eligibility.
- 2. If you have the OSU Student Health Insurance:
 - It is your responsibility to know what your particular health insurance benefits are regarding Physical Therapy and Sports Medicine before your first appointment.
 - Knowledge of remaining benefit balance and eligibility status is also your responsibility.
 - Any questions regarding your Student Health Insurance (SHI) benefits should be directed to the SHI office located at 830 Lincoln Tower; phone 614-688-7979.
- 3. If you do not have the OSU Student Health Insurance:
 - It is your responsibility to know what your particular health insurance benefits are regarding Physical Therapy and Sports Medicine before your first appointment.
 - It is your responsibility to give your outside health insurance information to the Patient Registration department on the ground floor before your first visit.
 - When verifying coverage for Dr. McGrath, please make sure that your insurance will cover him at the Wilce Student Health Center location (1875 Millikin Road, Columbus, OH, 43210).
- 4. If you have questions regarding billing, you may call our Revenue Cycle team at 614-292-0113 or visit the Patient Registration department located on the ground floor.
- 5. If you are late for your appointment:
 - You will be asked to reschedule your appointment and will be charged a \$25 fee.
 - Notifying the department that you will be late to your appointment does not guarantee that we will be able to treat you.
 - If you miss your appointment you will be charged a \$25 fee.
- 6. If you need to cancel your appointment:
 - You need to contact the department by calling 614-292-0130 at least 24 hours prior to your scheduled appointment time.
 - If your appointment is cancelled with less than a 24 hour notice, you will be charged a \$25 fee.
- 7. Your Physical Therapy Prescription:
 Your prescription is good for one month only from the date of the prescribing provider's visit.
- 8. If you have more than one diagnosis on your Physical Therapy prescription, you will need to make separate appointments for each initial evaluation.

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- 9. If you are having a prescription faxed to the department, please contact our office at 614-292-0130 the day before your appointment to determine if we have received the updated prescription.
- 10. Your visit will last approximately 45 minutes to 1 hour.
- 11. If your prescription says "Iontophoresis," you must go to the Pharmacy on the ground floor before your first visit to pick up the required medication.
- 12. You must bring your white appointment slip with you to each visit to verify your appointment.
- 13. Please bring comfortable clothes with you for your appointment in Physical Therapy or Sports Medicine: Shorts or sweat pants, T-shirt, and athletic shoes.
- 14. Personal items, including cell phones, will be placed in lockers during your appointment.
- 15. There is no charge for your initial Thera-Band. For a replacement or additional Thera-bands, there will be a \$6.00 fee.

To ensure that you are seen as close to your scheduled appointment time as possible, we have a few recommendations:

- 1. For your Physical Therapy appointment, please make sure that you bring your white appointment slip and your Physical Therapy prescription with you.
 - Without the prescription, you cannot receive treatment.
 - We will reschedule you if you do not have your prescription at the time of your appointment.
- 2. Arrive early to your appointment.
- 3. If you have another appointment at the health center, please allow time to make sure that you will not be late for your Physical Therapy or Sports Medicine appointment.
 - If you are late, you will need to reschedule your appointment.
- 4. You may park in the Wilce Student Health Center facility lot.
 - Access the parking lot from Annie and John Glenn Ave Avenue to Millikin Road. Follow Millikin Road to the parking area under the facility.
 - Parking for patients is available in the garage underneath the building. You will need to obtain a promo code from the Patient Registration or Information Desk staff in order to receive the discounted rate of \$3.75.
 - Inability to find parking will not be accepted as an excuse for being late for your appointment.

To schedule an online appointment for Physical Therapy, you must follow these guidelines:

- 1. You can only schedule a follow-up appointment. Do not schedule an initial evaluation with a Physical Therapist.
- 2. You must have been seen by your Physical Therapist within the past 5 days.
- 3. You can only schedule one appointment. Do not schedule multiple Physical Therapy appointments.
